DIRECTOR of Foundation for Rural Integrated Enterprises & Development Sashi Kiran is one of the seven speakers at the inaugural TEDxSuva live event today.

The FRIEND founder said to coincide with the theme "Contemporary Voyage", she would be sharing her journey and experiences with the organisation and people involved.

"It is actually quite amazing to be one of the seven in the inaugural event and listening to the preview stories of the other speakers, there's so much strength and so much creative stories out there," Ms Kiran said.

"We have been very heavily involved with Cyclone Winston relief works so it has been very interesting to be out there in the field and in here preparing for the event."

Event MC Mere Nailatikau said there had been a positive response from the public and all 100 seats had been filled.
